The Region known as "Costa Chica" lies on the Pacific coast of Oaxaca and Guerrero, Mexico. Dance is an important element of the coast's cultural life. Dance in this area is an melting pot of the Mexican indigenous, South American, African, and Spanish elements much like the rest of its culture. Authorities here, including village elders, the town councils, municipal authorities, as well as important village figures have worked to keep traditions, such as the "sones" (traditional music) and "chilenas" (dance performed particularly in Pinotepa Nacional) alive. Many dances from this region, including the Costa Chica are very peculiar due to the fact that the dancers carry a red handkerchief. This is used to mimic the mating ritual of the rooster and the hen, where the male dancer leads signaling the female dancer with the movement of the handkerchief. Chilenas originated from the region of Central and South America acquiring its own style in Mexico. MDE is a non for profit organization focused on providing a challenging environment that promotes cultural awareness, preserves Mexican Folklore, and cultivates dance by striving to reach a high level of artistic excellence. The company's main objectives are to offer a performing platform for emerging artists, and expand the importance and value of the arts.
